Dear District and CCN Residents:

The district is pleased to present its first Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) since water service was initiated by the district for the Emerald Bay Community in August 2006.

The Consumer Confidence Report is a state mandated report and by law must contain certain subject matter as prescribed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). It is intended to insure that consumers of public water are informed as to the condition of their public water supply. Required information relating to public education, where your water comes from, public participation opportunities, and testing results supplied to the district by the TCEQ are included and required.

You will notice that the **RESULTS** section of this report shows only limited data in some areas. This is because the district was issued *conditional well permits* to commence operations in August of 2006. Those permits are based on *privately obtained lab samples and test results* submitted to the TCEQ when our water wells were drilled. Privately obtained test results are not supplied back to the district for this report. Next year's report, representing calendar year 2007, will contain expanded lab results representing *state obtained samples and test results*. Those samples have already been taken by TCEQ contractors and are currently being analyzed. Please be aware that this is the normal TCEQ process for new public water well startups. Additionally, through automation technology, we are now checking the disinfectant residual (chlorine) every 30 minutes on a 24/7 basis, and we have had **no** positive coliform or fecal coliform results since startup.

Lastly, as of this date, we are pleased to announce that the water system has received no violations or correction directives, and all operations are normal. Your continued confidence and support is sincerely appreciated.
