Notes to Applicants:

TRCC inspection is required on all new construction and renovations in excess of \$10,000.00 in Texas. TRCC inspections do not include plumbing inspections. Local ordinances and TCEQ rules require plumbing inspection by licensed plumbing inspectors.

All required “Plumbing Inspection Escrow Funds” and “TRCC Inspection Fee” (If Requested) are due at the time of application and payable directly to the District. There is no Emerald Bay HOA building permit, or MUD Plumbing Inspection for construction within The Windcliff Harbor Subdivision – Wastewater Tap Fee and/or Transfer Fees Only.

The District requires that water taps and water meters be installed by District personnel or the District designee only. Wastewater (Sewer) taps may be installed by any licensed plumber but **must** be left uncovered until the actual tap connection is inspected by a district officer or designee.

Any associated connection cost incurred by the District such as meters, excavation, boring, connection parts, and labor are billed directly to the applicant, at actual cost (no markup), when service connections are completed and in service.
